LOCATION:	Got Osimbo (Western Kenya)
OBJECTIVE:	Build a high school to further the education of students who come from two local Christian primary schools.

High School Strategy:

- 1) After a careful analysis of the surrounding primary schools in Msambweni, we have identified two Christian primary schools and two government schools where children can receive a primary level education. We will focus on the two Christian primary schools.
 - a) Msingi Bora Primary School: Run on Christian principles and is a complete primary school (KG1-Standard Eight), registered by the Government of Kenya.
 - b) KAG School: Run on Christian principles and has several children from the Blessed Camp Community forwarded by Action Ministry already learning here. It is registered by the Government of Kenya.
- 2) Establishing a school in Western Kenya (Got-Osimbo) has been in the long-term plan of Action Ministry since the beginning.

Action High School Vision:

The vision of Action Ministry for the Action High School is to provide a holistic education and discipleship that will transform young people and the community.

- 1) Msambweni (Blessed Camp area) and the Coastal region is a predominantly Muslim stronghold with Christians as the minority. Islam is almost the 'official religion' of the region.
 - Almost every institution of higher learning in the Coastal region (high schools and colleges) have a Mosque in the compound.
 - They insist that the institution must teach Islamic Religious Studies.
 - They insist that children, especially girls, must dress the Islamic way -- that is, the Hijab.
 - In some cases, there have been instances where Christian worship in schools, like praying and singing in the assembly, has been prohibited or received with 'hostility.'
- 2) Given this background, for Action Ministry to achieve its vision of a holistic education and discipleship, it will be wise to have the institution in a Christian friendly environment.
 - The children from the Blessed Camp Community who are supported by the Ministry, upon completion of primary school will be admitted at the Action High School in Got Osimbo (Western Kenya) as boarders. They will therefore continue with their educational pursuit in an environment that allows them to not only receive high quality academic knowledge, but also Christian discipleship and mentorship.



Action High School Vision (cont.):

- The Kenyan government has a policy to integrate children from different regions and communities. This is done by posting them to high schools in different regions other than where they were born and received primary school education in an effort to promote greater nationality and cohesion in the country. Through the Action High School in Got Osimbo we will be giving the Blessed Camp children an opportunity of integration and promoting this important national value.
- Note: The Children from Blessed Camp having been born and raised in an environment of rejection and ‘seclusion’ will highly benefit from exposure and integration.
- Statistics have proved that the people in Western Kenya give more value to academic pursuit compared to the Coastal region; the level of competitiveness is therefore very high resulting in higher academic performance and achievement. This environment will be a good challenge for children from Blessed Camp as they will put more emphasis on class work leading to good performance.
- Since the Western Kenya community has a higher value for education, this will ensure that the school attracts fee-paying students, hence creating a source of sustainability for the school.
